- A signed affidavit in which the applicant confirms the accuracy of all information provided in the application and the attached documents. (A false statement may result in criminal prosecution.)

GDPR (DSGVO)

1. For what purpose is your personal data processed?

HTU stores and processes your personal data provided in this document (e.g., name, date of birth, telephone number, income, etc.) for the purpose of providing you with financial support in accordance with the guidelines of the HTU Graz social fund.

2. On what legal basis is your personal data processed?

The processing is based on your consent on the application form in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR. You give your consent voluntarily, without being legally or contractually obliged to do so. Please note, however, that we cannot process your application without your consent and that in this case you will not be eligible for the social fund.

3. To whom does HTU disclose your personal data?

Your data will be shared with the supervisory authority in accordance with the laws applicable to HTU. Apart from that, the data will not be transferred to any other recipients.



4. How long does HTU retain your personal data?

HTU generally stores your personal data for seven years. In addition, HTU stores your personal data if this is necessary to assert or defend legal claims.

5. What rights do you have in connection with the processing of your personal data?

The EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR) grants you, as the data subject, certain rights, which we will outline below. Please note that these rights are complementary, meaning that you can only request either the correction or completion of your data or its deletion.

Withdrawal of consent

If HTU stores and processes your personal data on the basis of your consent, you are entitled to revoke your consent at any time. However, this does not affect the legality of the processing carried out up to the point of revocation.

Right to information

You may request information about the origin, categories, storage period, recipients, purpose of the data processed by HTU about you, and the type of processing. You are not entitled to this right if HTU is acting in an official capacity and the information would jeopardize the fulfillment of a task assigned to it by law.

Right to rectification and erasure

If HTU processes data relating to you that is inaccurate or incomplete, you may request that it be corrected or completed. You may also request the erasure of unlawfully processed data.

Right to restriction of processing

If it is unclear whether the data processed about you is inaccurate or incomplete or is being processed unlawfully, you may request the restriction of the processing of your data until this issue has been finally clarified.

Right to object

Even if your personal data is correct and complete and is being processed lawfully by HTU, you can object to the processing of this data. However, this is only possible in special situations, which you must justify.

Right to data portability

You can receive the data processed by HTU about you, which HTU itself has received from you, in a machine-readable format specified by HTU, or you can instruct HTU to transfer this data directly to a third party of your choice, provided that this recipient enables HTU to do so from a technical point of view and that the data transfer does not involve an unreasonable effort or conflict with legal or other confidentiality obligations or confidentiality considerations on the part of HTU or third parties.

Right to lodge a complaint

Finally, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the GDPR.
